#### The fresh food wholesale markets in Europe





#### Main products from Western Balkan inside European Wholesale Markets



**France: Rungis Wholesale Market** 

Black trumpet mushrooms from **Bosnia and Herzegovina and Croatia** are delivered through the Muscherum wholesaler, constituting 2% of their total tonnage.



**Greece: Athens Wholesale Market** 

Periodically imports berries, tomatoes

Meat from Serbia used to be considered as very high quality some years ago.



Romania

Cabbages / peaches / nectarines / apricots from the Western Balkans are popular to Wholesale markets, but not in regular basis



**Turkey: Istanbul** 

They have imported 173 tons of persimmon from North Macedonia in 2023.

#### The Serbian Success Story in European Wholesale Markets



**The Plum** 



Transportation esp. of red fruits and berries to wholesale markets of Northern Europe is challenging due to the fragility of the products and the lengthy transfer process from western Balkans.






Lack of standardization leads to unequal qualities of lots.

Wholesalers and Supermarkets require the most homogenized product possible.



The combination of Low standardization and transportation faults usually results in products that come to the target market **very close to ripening quality**. So they have to be distributed very fast.


Tolls, licensing and bureaucracy are creating **extra delays** in the crossborder transportations



#### Awareness and acceptance

Wholesalers from most European wholesale markets are unfamiliar with the variety of production from Western Balkans.

They express a desire to learn more about the production in these countries.



### Competition From Other Countries from EU

Mediterranean EU countries have similar production at the same seasons, but better know how and less red tape implications



### Competition From Other Countries from Non-EU

Other non- EU countries have already taken advantage of privileged access (Morocco/Algeria) or state funding (Turkey)



#### Suggestions

- Standardization
- Focused marketing Strategy
- Improvement of transportation means and cold chain storage
- Acquisition of know how in production, parceling and market penetration
